### **The Ed & Margaret Guertin Scholarship (\$1,000)**

#### ***Description of Scholarship Program***

At the encouragement of Mr. Ed Guertin of the **St. Boniface-St. Vital Kiwanis Club**, a Student Scholarship Fund was established as an award for students graduating from high school or presently enrolled in a post-secondary institution.

In support of the St. Amant's Student Volunteer Program, the scholarship recognizes individuals who have made a significant contribution through their volunteer efforts.

In 2007 this fund was renamed The Ed & Margaret Guertin Scholarship Fund in honour of the late Ed Guertin. Mr. Guertin set a high example of volunteerism; during his lifetime as he sat on many Winnipeg boards and committees in an effort to help others in our community. Mr. Guertin was an ambassador of St. Amant as he believed in its good work and the service it provides to children and adults with developmental disabilities. Mr. Guertin was also inspired by the youth who were dedicated to volunteering at St. Amant. In fact Mr. Guertin was so impressed by student volunteerism at St. Amant, that in the first year the scholarship was established he donated the funds to award scholarships to two additional students.

It was the goal of Mr. Guertin and the **St. Boniface-St. Vital Kiwanis Club** to provide not only opportunities for highly motivated individuals, but also to encourage the average student to become civic minded and to acknowledge and reward that initiative.

### **Robert F. De Leeuw Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000)**

#### ***Description of the Scholarship Program***

In light of the giving nature of Robert De Leeuw, a Scholarship Fund was established as an award for students graduating from high school or enrolled in a post-secondary institution.

In support of the St. Amant's Student Volunteer Program, the scholarship recognizes individuals who have made a significant contribution through their volunteer efforts to support children and adults with developmental disabilities and autism.

In 2017, this fund, The Robert F. De Leeuw Memorial Scholarship, was created by Robert's parents, Bert & Marilyn De Leeuw. Robert set a high example of volunteerism; during his lifetime, he was always willing to lend a helping hand with the philanthropic efforts of the St. Boniface-St. Vital Kiwanis with their annual golf tournaments, selling tickets at their annual Fall Sportsmen's Dinners and the annual Holiday hamper drives. His donation of time and effort to ensure a fundraiser's success was truly admired and appreciated by those he helped.
