

Multiple Stimulus with Replacement

Student requirements: The student must be able to choose from a range of items

Target behaviour: The student touches any part of the item.

Instructions

1. Select items: Select up to 7 stimuli to evaluate, and write the name of the stimulus on the yellow column.
2. Prepare the area: Clear the assessment area of any distractors and arrange the stimuli in a semi-circle on a table, spread out equally from each other, and from the student.
3. Sample the stimuli: Bring student into assessment area and prompt them to interact with each item for 30 seconds. No recording is needed.
4. Present the stimuli: Instruct student to interact with one of the available stimuli (e.g., pick one).
 - Allow the student to interact with the chosen item for 30s, then return the item rearranging the order of the stimuli (e.g., rotate clockwise).
 - Block attempts to interact with more than one stimulus.
 - Mark the the item selected in the first trial in green column.
 - Repeat the procedure until either all items are selected, or until the student makes no choice within 30 seconds from the trials for the same amount or times as the number of items. If no selection is made in 30 seconds, the trial ends and all remaining items are recorded as "not recorded."
 - Repeat the session/assessment (3 to 5 times) and register the choice on the indicated column.
5. Results: Write the total amount of times the stimulus was selected and presented, in the pink column, then calculate the percentage of times the stimulus was selected.
